

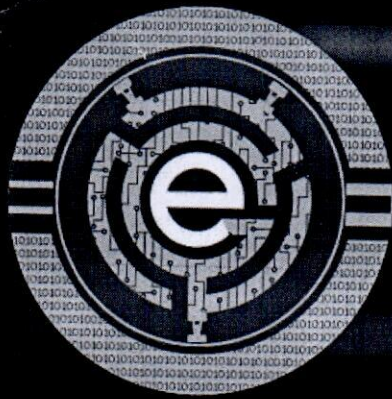

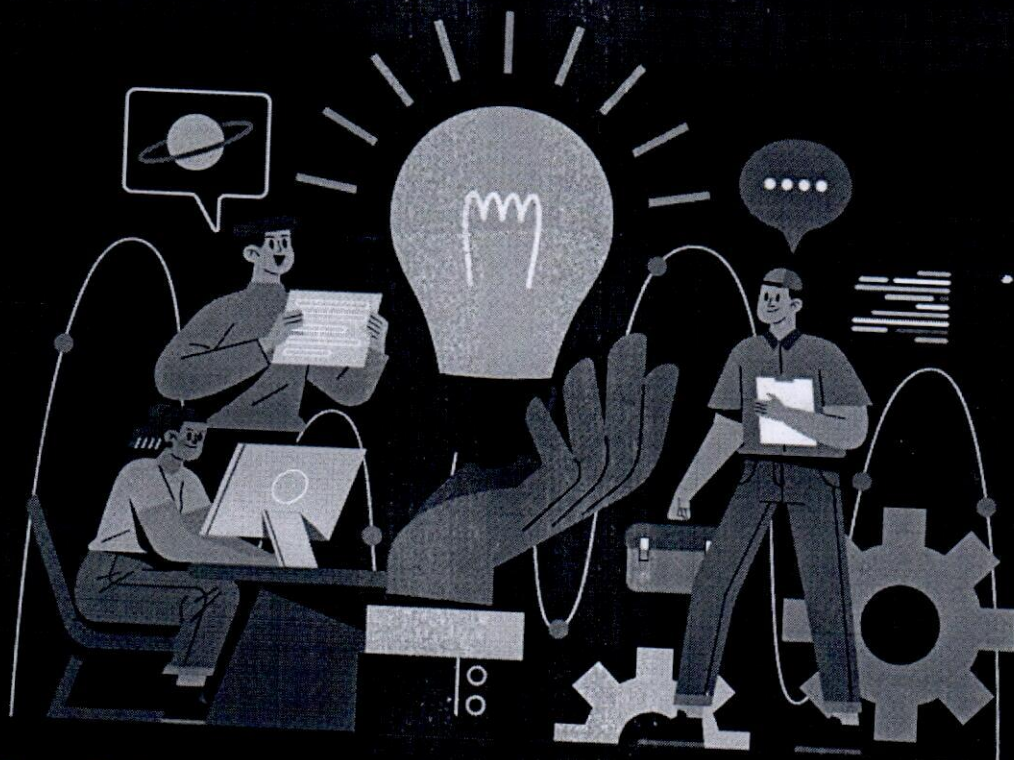




# About eRaksha Competition 2022
